PUBLIC NOTICE INVITATION FOR BID TRANSIT BUS WASH SYSTEM

The Mercer County Regional Council of Governments (MCRCOG) is the administrative agency for Shenango Valley Shuttle Service (SVSS) and Mercer County Community Transit (MCCT). SVSS and MCCT provide transportation services in the Shenango Valley. SVSS is seeking bids for a Transit Bus Wash system. The new bus wash system will replace the current bus wash system ("Super Scout II" by Whiting) located at the Operations facility, 5200 Virginia Road, Hermitage, PA 16148.

The scope of work for this project includes but is not limited to the demolition and removal of the old system and the installation of a new bus wash system. The Invitation For Bid (IFB) Package provides the complete scope of work as well as bid requirements.
